## **HISTORY**

The Amelia Island Nassau County Association of REALTORS® Honor Society was approved by Board of Directors in 1990 with implementation in 1991 in order to enhance and recognize the professional standards of the Association membership through voluntary educational offerings, participation at the local Association, State and National levels and through service to the community.

#### **PURPOSE**

The primary purpose of the Honor Society is to encourage Association participation among REALTOR® members in order that they might be better educated, active members, to serve their clients, and in turn, bring credit to themselves and the real estate industry. The program is designed for both the new REALTORS® as well as those who have held Association membership for a number of years. It is not intended to recognize or reward members who are not actively participating in Association of REALTORS® functions.

#### **AWARDS**

Certificates recognizing membership in the Honor Society are presented at the Annual Installation and Awards Banquet in January of each succeeding year.

#### YEARLY QUALIFICATION

To maintain membership in the AINCAR Honor Society, members must qualify each year by obtaining a minimum of 100 points per year. This is NOT a one-time qualification and is designed to keep Association members active and involved.

# **QUALIFICATION PERIOD**

The qualification period of application year will run from January 1 to December 31. All applications must be submitted to the Amelia Island Nassau County Association of REALTORS®, 910 South 14th Street, Fernandina Beach, FL 32034 by January 5th of following year.

## POINT QUALIFICATION

A minimum of 100 points per year is needed in order to qualify or maintain membership in the Amelia Island Nassau County Honor Society. Orientation and Continuing Education Courses are excluded from any points earned. The application lists in detail the point breakdown by category. Points in varying amounts are set forth by the three categories. The Awards sub-committee of the Membership Committee will verify and recommend approval of the applications to the Directors.
